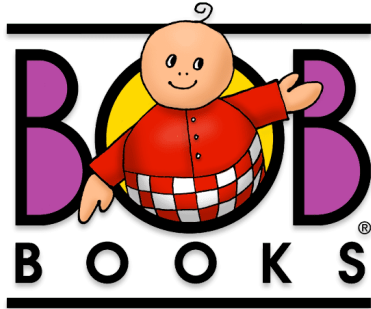


# BOOK SERIES FOR INTERVENTION
