Teacher: What sound?

Student: /k/

IMMEDIATE FEEDBACK

If correct:

Right, /b/. Nice job! What's a word that starts with /b/?

If incorrect or "I don't know":

The letter "b" makes the sound /b/. What sound? (Child repeats) Right, /b/. Well done!
